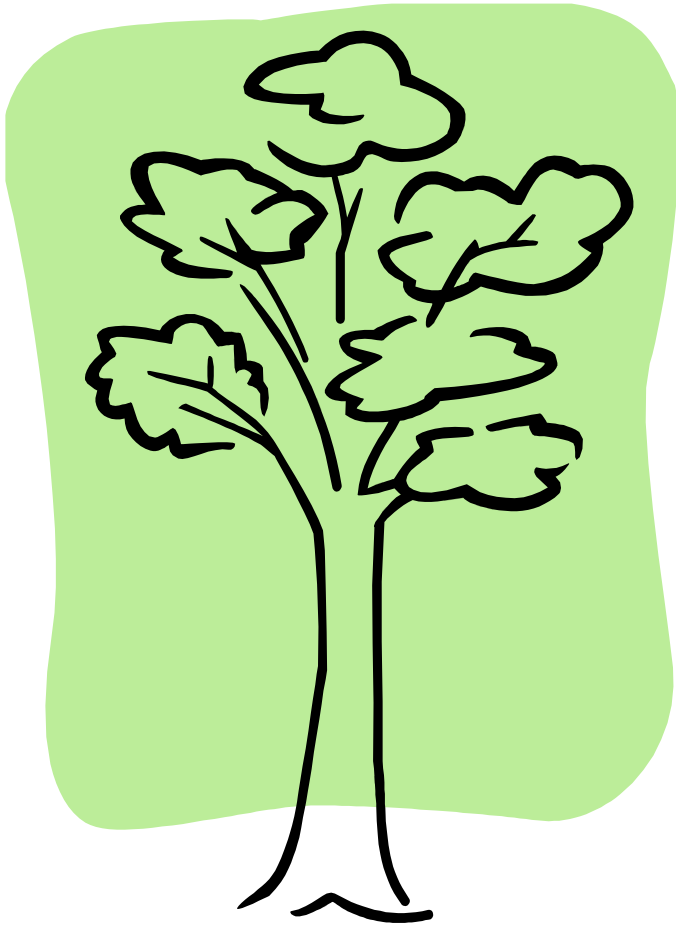


Tree of Life Celebration!

In May of 2003, the Public Awareness Workgroup of the Pilot (now known as the Early Childhood Council) began the Tree of Life Project.
