Transcripts issued to the student, hand-carried, or faxed cannot be accepted. <i>Only students who have graduated high school within the last five years are required to submit a high school transcript.</i></li> <li>3. Submit ACT/SAT scores or schedule an appointment to take the <a href="#">Accuplacer Placement Test</a>.</li> <li>4. Schedule an appointment with a <a href="#">College Counselor</a>.</li> <li>5.
